"A New Song"


Psalm 149:1-2 - Praise the LORD! Sing to the LORD a new song, His praise in the assembly of the godly! Let Israel be glad in his Maker; let the children of Zion rejoice in their King!

It is a new song about an ancient promise fulfilled, God's promise to send a Savior. The Lord our Maker chose us in Christ Jesus to be His holy people. We were not chosen because we stopped sinning or tried very hard to obey His commandments. We were not chosen because we performed the correct ceremonies and brought the right offerings. We were not even chosen because we were singing all the right songs! God chose us in Christ Jesus to be His holy people before we were born, before the world was created.

Our new song celebrates this new thing God has done. He chose us by grace, His undeserved favor for sinners. The mighty Creator of all things, who created everything from oceans to insects, who set the stars and planets in motion, yet knows when even a sparrow falls, chose us—sinners all—to create for Himself "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His own possession" (1 Peter 2:9a). This is something to sing about, with songs both new *and* old!

Our new song is also about being made new. We have been baptized into Christ, united to His death, burial, and resurrection. We are raised to walk in newness of life and each of us is a new creation. All of this newness has come about because of a new covenant, in which God says of the people He creates and claims for Himself: "I will be their God, and they shall be My people ... I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more" (Jeremiah 31:33b, 34b). It is a covenant sealed in the blood of Jesus Christ.

Finally, when Jesus returns, God will create a new heaven and a new earth. Raised bodily from death as Jesus was raised, we will join the saints and angels singing praise to God our Maker and Redeemer: "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!" (Revelation 5:12b). It will be a new song, and it will never get old.
