Stewardship Thoughts

“But Jesus answered him, ‘Let it be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.’”
- Matthew 3:15

God sent His Son into the world to fulfill all righteousness for us, to do what we could not do. Here, Jesus plunges Himself into our sins and soaks them up in His Baptism, so that in our Baptism we might be cleansed and renewed. The whole of Jesus’ life, everything He did and said, was one great offering to the Father in our stead to fulfill all righteousness for us. All our offerings back to our Lord are in thanksgiving for this one great, true offering.

When Jesus asked to be baptized,
 He had nothing of which to repent.

In gracious obedience, He was baptized to begin this wonderful exchange with us sinners, fulfilling the Law in our place and taking upon Himself God’s judgment against sin. Indeed, the Father was pleased with His servant Son that day but forsook Him on the cross as He took our sins with Him.
