***Holy Trinity Sunday***

*All good things come in three. That proverb has existed through many ages, languages, and cultures.*

*This morning, Holy Trinity Sunday, the Christian Church celebrates the doctrine of the Trinity, which expresses the divine truth that God is Three in One and One in Three.*

*Our worship becomes celebration as we express our faith in and love for the Holy Trinity—God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.*

We have not fully followed the promptings and leading of the Holy Spirit. We have not always honored the strong name of the Trinity in thought, word, and deed.

**C: Almighty God, I repent of my sins and seek Your mercy. Be gracious to me and for the sake of Jesus, my Redeemer, grant me Your forgiveness so that, as Your redeemed child, I may find the joy of absolution and, with a heart renewed by the Spirit, serve You in time and in eternity.**

P: In the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ☩ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

**C: Amen.**

P: The Lord be with you.

**C: And also with you.**

P: Together, we pray

**C: Almighty God our Father, dwelling in majesty and filling creation with Your Spirit, reveal Your glory through our Lord Jesus Christ, cleanse us from doubt and fear, and send us boldly into all the world to worship You, with Your Son and the Holy Spirit, one God, living and reigning, now and forever, Amen.**
