St. Andrew, Apostle *Christ the King* Sunday, November, 26, 2023, 11:15am



St. Andrew, also called St. Andrew the Apostle, one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus is the brother of St. Peter. He is the patron saint of Scotland and Russia.

In the Synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke), Peter and Andrew were called from their fishing by Jesus to follow Him, promising that He would make them fishers of men.

Early church legends recount his missionary activity in the area about the Black Sea. A 4th-century account reports his death by crucifixion, and late medieval writings describe the cross as X-shaped. He is represented with an X-shaped cross like that depicted on the Scottish flag.
