Some years ago, a 14-foot bronze crucifix was stolen from Calvary Cemetery in Little Rock, Arkansas. It had stood at the entrance to the cemetery for more than 50 years. The cross was put there in 1930 by a Catholic bishop and had been valued, at the time, at \$10,000. The thieves cut it off at the base, hauled it off, cut it into small pieces, and sold it for scrap. They received \$450. They obviously didn't realize the value of that cross. That's the problem with our lost world, misunderstanding the value of the cross. Not only do people not see the value of Jesus, they also misunderstand the value of His death. May we not be so blind!
