Amazing is a commonly used word that has a rich history.

It came into common usage in the 14th century as a variant of the older root word "amasod", which meant dazed, confounded, or overwhelmed with sudden surprise or wonder.

The word "amazing" shows up several times in hymns, from describing the action of God in the birth of Jesus as love amazing, to bringing to our hearts and minds that in His suffering to pay the price of our sins, our Lord showed amazing pity.

Two other hymns refer to the amazing grace of God, and in another hymn, the author of the text rejoices that God has done amazing things
