P: The Almighty and Merciful Lord grant you pardon, forgiveness, and remission of all your sins. As a called and ordained servant of Jesus and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the \(\Pi\) Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen.

P: The Lord be with you.
