The Sacrament of Holy Baptism Rowan Jean Carney

P: Dearly beloved, Jesus says in the last chapter of Matthew, All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. In the last chapter of Mark God promises, Whoever believes, and is baptized, will be saved. And Peter has written, Baptism now saves you.

The Word of God also teaches that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Jesus claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son, who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Rowan, receive the sign of the cross both upon your † forehead and upon your † heart to mark you as one redeemed by Jesus.

Let us pray, Almighty God, according to Your judgment You condemned the unbelieving world through the flood, yet according to Your mercy You preserved believing Noah and his family, eight souls in all. Through the Baptism in the Jordan of Your Son, You sanctified and instituted all waters to be a blessed flood and a lavish washing away of sin.

They are, whenever possible, to witness the Baptism of those they sponsor. They are to pray for them, support them in their ongoing instruction and nurture in the Christian faith, and encourage them toward the faithful reception of the Lord's Supper. They are at all times to be examples of the Holy life of faith in Jesus and love for each other.

Sara and Andrew, is it your intention to serve Rowan as sponsors in the Christian faith?

P: God enable you to do this faithful and loving work and with His grace fulfill what we are unable to do.

Sponsors: Amen.

Adam: Hear now the Gospel according to St. Mark: They brought young children to Jesus that He might touch them, but the disciples rebuked those who brought them. But when Jesus saw it, He was greatly displeased and said to them, Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them, for of such is the kingdom of God. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from thence He will come to judge the living and the dead?

P: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting?

Yes, I believe.

P: Emily and Thomas, do you desire Rowan to be baptized into the Christian faith?

Emily/Thomas: Yes, we do.
