BUILDING HEALTHY FAMILIES

In addition to pervasive sadness, feeling hopeless and disconnected from others, another sign of depression is distorted thinking. Examples include overgeneralizing – after one thing goes wrong, saying, "Things never go right for me;" exaggerated responsibility for others - "Why aren't you happy? It must be because of something I did or didn't do;" and negative labeling – "I didn't get up in time to exercise today – I'm lazy and a failure." Left unchallenged, these false negative messages to self only deepen the despair. Depression is not a lack of faith or a character flaw, but a serious illness which when left untreated can destroy a life, a marriage and a family. It is treatable and you can feel better. See your medical doctor first and remember that your pastor and Christian counselors like those at Lutheran Family Service who also share your faith can help.
