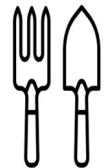

7. Nail Clippers

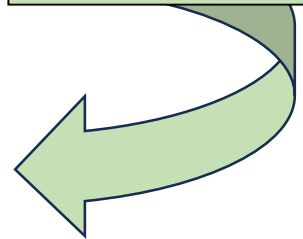
