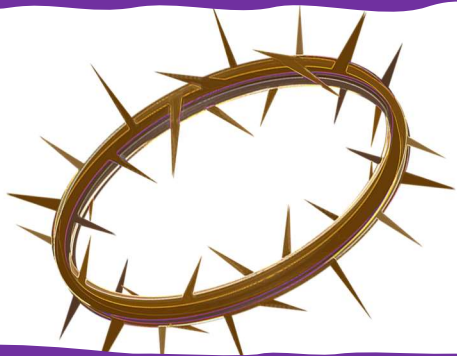
A Brief Statement about Holy Communion

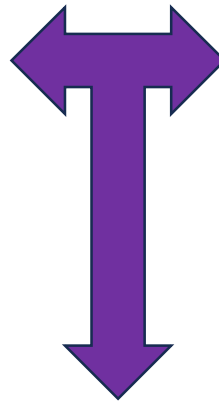
