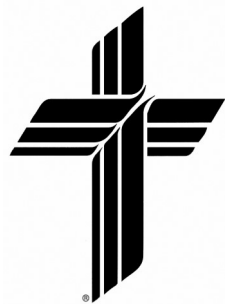

You may have heard a song, usually played around Easter or sometimes at weddings, the Toccata from the Fifth Symphony by Charles Marie Widor (1844-1937). Although this is probably his most well-known and most-performed movement, Widor composed ten organ symphonies - which are organ solos with several movements. Widor, born into a family of organ builders, was appointed as a provisional organist of Saint-Sulpice in Paris in 1870, the most prominent position for a French organist of the time, a where he remained for nearly 64 years. Today's prelude is the third movement from another one of his compositions, the fourth organ symphony, commonly known as the Andante Cantabile after its tempo marking, meaning "songlike".
