## About Communion:

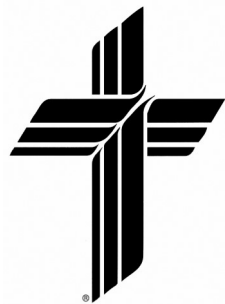
