Please join volunteers and staff (738 Blair Ave) to celebrate and pray over the house, dedicating it and committing all who will come there to the Lord's love and care.

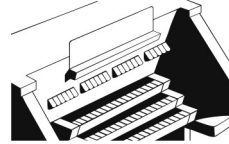

Johann Pachelbel (1653-1695) was a German organist and composer who also taught organ. One of his pupils was Johann Christoph Bach, who in turn gave his younger brother Johann Sebastian Bach his first formal keyboard lessons.

Although his most famous work is the Canon in D, Pachelbel also contributed to the development of the chorale prelude and fugue. A toccata by Joahnn Pachelbel

serves as our postlude today (8:00).
