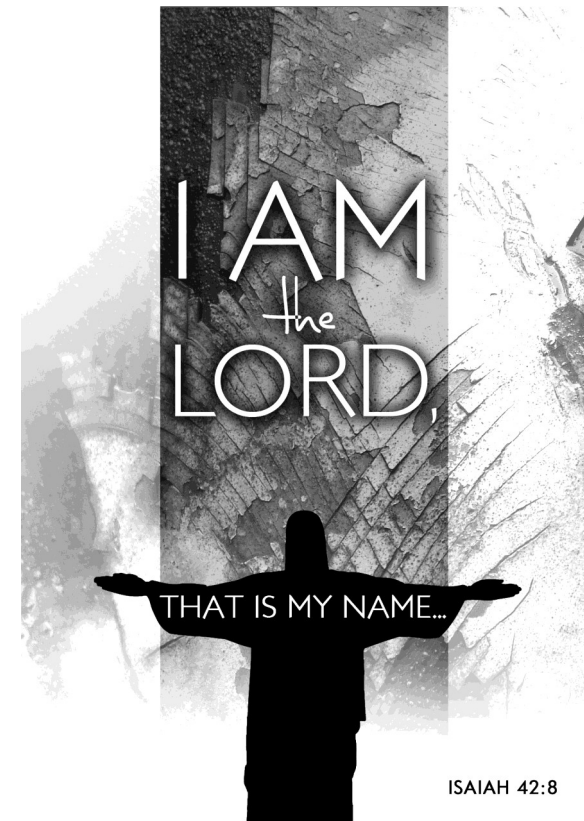

Recovery from forced displacement requires a supportive community, life-giving faith and emotional well-being along with the ability to navigate and contribute to society.

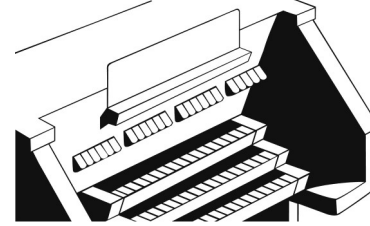

### From the **ORGANIST**



**Franz Joseph Hayden** (1732-1809), was an Austrian composer. Among his compositions are 108 symphonies, in which he developed the form and style of the Classical symphony, earning him the title "father of the symphony". Hayden was also instrumental in developing the string quartet. The musical clock, or flute clock, was an eighteenth century clock which included a small

mechanized organ including its own set of pipes to play short pieces. This luxury item could get quite elaborate including intricate carvings, parts that moved in time to the music, and multiple stops. Among Hayden's friends and fellow musicians, were George Pyke and Joseph Niemez, both of whom created several of these musical clocks. Hayden (as well as other composers such as Handel, Mozart, and Beethoven) composed works specifically for these instruments. Today's prelude is selections from Hayden's pieces written for the musical clock.

**On the third Sunday of each month,** our church collects your pocket change for "mites for missions" in the big mite box in the narthex.
