Food Distribution - After the unrest, a lot of food resources were being brought to bear on the neighborhoods of St. Paul and Minneapolis, but many of those have come to a stop. St. Stephanus is planning to continue its food distributions into October on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays of the month. Our distribution this week gave out over 14,000 pounds of food to around 180 households.

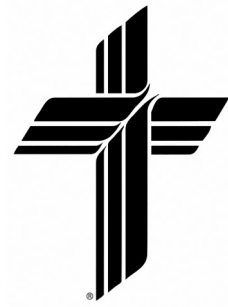
