The Bible is a big collection of books, with the central narrative of God's work ultimately up to and through Jesus of Nazareth, the Messiah, the Christ, the Son of the Living God. The Spirit of God speaks to us through this book into this day – holding an ancient text and our modern world and inviting us to think, look and speak of the movement of God on this Earth. Choose a book of the Bible to read – set a time frame (this week? This month? This summer? Read through the Gospels? The Prophets? The Psalms?)

Read to listen to the voice of God, to better hear it speaking in this day.

Reflect:

God speaks to us through His word in the Bible, and the word made flesh in Jesus. The Spirit guides us in this. How have we invited the Spirit to guide, that is, the Spirit *is* there to guide – are we paying attention to the word, our neighbor, our world?

Respond:

The Spirit of God is alive and active in this present day.
