Samuel Barber (1910-1981), was an American composer, pianist, conductor and singer. A graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music in Philadelphia. He devoted himself to composition. His distinctive and modern style made him one of the most expressive representatives of the lyric and Romantic trends in 20th-century classical music. Among Barber's compositions are two string quartets, one composed in 1936, known as Opus 11. After hearing the slow second movement of this piece, the acclaimed Italian composer Arturo Toscanini urged Barber to arrange the movement for full orchestra, and in 1938 Toscanini premiered the new work ovia a radio broadcast with the NBC Symphony Orchestra. The *Adagio for Strings*, as the new piece was quickly named,

became a huge success and was played at the funeral of Albert Einstein, has been used in several commercials and movie soundtracks, and was even arranged into a choral version, *Agnus Dei*. A setting of this piece, transcribed for organ, will serve as our prelude today.
