April 23, 2023 Third Sunday of Easter

Our Hymn of the Day today, as we continue the Season of Easter, is "With High Delight Let Us Unite." This hymn by Georg Vetter (1536-99) was first published in 1566, a year before the author's ordination to the priesthood of the Unitas Fratrum, in a collection of six hymns dedicated to the Holy Roman Emperor Maximillian II. The hymn also appears in a collection of Wittenberg hymns from 1573. Aside from these hymns, Vetter's other known writings are in Czech. The original hymn was thirteen stanzas long and featured an acrostic, with each of the thirteen letters in the phrase "Mediator Jesus" (a reflection, perhaps of Hebrews 9:15, "He is the mediator of a new covenant") used in turn as the first letter of a stanza. After centuries of disuse, four stanzas of the hymn were brought back in a 1932 collection. Condensed to three stanzas in the Evangelisches Kirchengesangbuch (1950), it was appointed Hymn of the Day for Jubilate Sunday, the fourth Sunday of Easter, in the German evangelical churches.

Our translation by Martin Franzmann (1907-76) first appeared in the Missouri Synod's *Worship Supplement* of 1969. It is notable for Franzmann's gifted and meticulous preservation of Vetter's original rhyme scheme, in which lines 1 and 2 rhyme, also 4 and 5, 7 and 8, and 9 and 10, while lines 3, 6, and 11 also rhyme with one another, forming the rhyme scheme AA B CC B DD EE B.

Settings of the tune MIT FREUDEN ZART, which is named after the first line of the original text in German, will be played for prelude and postlude today.
