Johann Sebastian Bach wrote the cantata *Was mir behagt, ist nur die muntre Jagd* (tr: "The lively hunt is all my heart's desire", also known as the *Hunting Cantata* or the *Birthday Cantata* in 1713, in honor of the birthday of Duke Christian of Sachsen-Weissenfels. The Duke, an avid hunter. The ninth movement of the cantata is a soprano solo, "Sheep May Safely Graze," where the soloist explains that sheep may graze safely where there's a good shepherd who stays awake and where there's a good nobleman watching over a blissful nation. This sentiment also holds true today, on which we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday following the theme of today's Gospel reading. A setting of this piece will be played as our prelude today.

Today's postlude is the first of Bach's eight "little" Prelude and Fugues. Although the authorship of these pieces has been long debated, many scholars agree that they were in fact composed by Bach, just simplified for use as teaching pieces for his beginning students.
