The strife is o'er, the battle done; Now is the victor's triumph won: Now be the song of praise begun. Alleluia!

The Latin hymn "Finita iam sunt prælia" appeared in a book of music for Jesuit schools, *Symphonia Sirenum Selectarum* (Cologne, 1695). Assertions have been made that the text dates from as early as the twelfth century, but no evidence for it exists from before 1695. The text may in fact be older, but it is difficult to know for sure, as books from the seventeenth century are

not yet well represented in searchable digital collections. The only English translation in common use today is by Francis Pott (1832-1909), who published it in his *Hymns Fitted to the Order of Common Prayer* (London, 1861). Today, on this Fifth Sunday of Easter, let us proclaim "The strife is o'er!"
