The chaconne, or ciacona in Italian, is a musical style made up of continuous variations, generally recognizable because of its short repeating bass line. The German composer Johann Pachelbel (1653-1706), although best known for his Canon in D, wrote several chaconnes, of which six survive, the best-known being the Chaconne in F minor. It begins with a theme and takes us on a trip progressing through twenty-one variations of the theme, eventually culminating in the final version which is almost an exact repeat of the original theme. This piece will be played for the prelude today.

This Thursday, May 18, is Ascension Day, the celebration of Christ ascending into heaven. Today's closing hymn was chosen to mark this day, and today's postlude will be a Pachelbel chorale setting of that hymn's tune, NUN FREUT EUCH.
