

September 3, 2023 Fourteenth Sunday after Pentecost



Sir George Elvey (1816-1893) is best known for his hymn tunes, including seven found in our hymnal today for which he is credited (did you know that in the back of the hymnal is an index by composer/author?) Elvey was born into a musical family in Canterbury England, where as a boy he served as chorister in Canterbury Cathedral and soon began taking on more prominent singing parts in the church services there. In 1835, after studying at the Royal Academy of Music in London, Elvey was appointed to the coveted post of organist and chorus master at St. George's Chapel, Windsor. Elvey held this post for forty-seven years, where he wrote many compositions, mostly for church service, but also including some for royal occasions.

Two of Elvey's most popular hymns are DIADEMATA ("Crown Him with Many Crowns") and ST. GEORGE'S WIND-SOR (Come, Ye Thankful People, Come). Among Elvey's organ works is a piece, "Rejoice in His Holy Name," which will be heard as our postlude today.
