Feb. 18, 2024 First Sunday in Lent Sunday



Johann Sebastian Bach set out to create a compilation of chorales fitting for each Sunday of the church year, which could be used as a teaching tool for organ students. The result was a set of forty-six Lutheran hymn tunes called the Orgelbüchlein (Little Organ Book). The chorale prelude on "O Mensch, bewein dein Sünde groß", (tr: "O man, bewail thy sins so great") is one of the longest of these settings. This is based on a hymn by Sebald Heyden describing the Passion in twenty-three stanzas. Chorale preludes of the time were often used as the hymn introduction, with the goal of put-

ting the congregation in the right mood for singing the hymn with even greater devotion. In this setting, Bach creates a highly ornamented melody line adding a complex harmony with many twists and turns, interpreting the sacrifice of Christ. The final phrase reaches a remarkable harmony leading into the final adagissimo, representing Bach's interpretation of the final words of the text: "Long suspended from the cross."
