March 3, 2024 Third Sunday in Lent Sunday



Martin Luther (1483-1546) expressed the wish in his Latin Mass (*Formula missae*, 1523) that "we had as many songs as possible in the vernacular which the people could sing during mass." That same year, he wrote several paraphrases of biblical psalms, including Psalms 12 and 14, which are no longer sung; Psalm 130 ("From depths of woe I cry to Thee," LSB 607), and the hymn "May God Bestow on Us His Grace," a paraphrase of Psalm 67. Luther's psalm paraphrases served both as example and catalyst toward the goal of providing German songs for the congregation.

He likely wrote the paraphrase of Psalm 67 in late 1523, since the text first appears appended to the end of a 1524 German translation of the *Formula missae*. On May 6, 1524, a man was arrested in Magdeburg for singing Luther's versifications of Psalms 67 and 130 and selling copies of them. It is possible that the earliest surviving copy of Luther's psalm with music, a broadsheet with the title *Der Lxfj. Deus Misereatur* printed in Magdeburg in 1524, was one of those sold.

The tune ES WOLLE GOTT UNS GNÄDIG SEIN is the tune from the Magdeburg broadsheet, and is found in our hymnal as #823. Today we will sing this as our Hymn of the Day, set to the tune ELVET BANKS, a relatively new (20th century) tune by British composer David Lee, named for his alma mater, the University of Durham.
