From country chapel to the largest urban cathedral, "Praise my Soul the King of heaven" remains one of the most popular of hymns. It was chosen by Queen Elizabeth to be the processional hymn for her wedding to Prince Philip in 1947. Its popularity is in part due to the familiar passage on which the hymn is based, "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name!" (Psalm 103:1), and to the highly successful wedding of this text to the tune LAUDA ANIMA, which John Goss (1800-80) composed specifically for this hymn.

This is the second of three paraphrases of Psalm 103 that Henry Francis Lyte (1793-1847) wrote for his parish in Devon, England. They were first published in 1834 in *The Spirit of the Psalms*, an ambitious collection of 280 texts that established Lyte as a poet and hymn writer of note. Another of Lyte's works found in our hymnal is "Abide with me, fast falls the eventide."
