NARRATOR: Jesus' birth was the long-awaited fulfillment of a promise given to a very special family. Born the son of a woman, yet born the Son of God, He came to be the Savior of all mankind. The Family Tree of Jesus is vast and as ancient as time itself. A Family whose members were all handpicked by God Himself. Today we remember just a few of these faithful Children of God.

NARRATOR: One of the names on Jesus' Family Tree is Jesse, a farmer who lived in Bethlehem. His son, the great King David, would be one of the most famous on the Family Tree. His family tree began with God's first promise of a Savior to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. It ended with the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem. Through the years the church has called this Family Tree the Jesse Tree. Today we celebrate God's faithfulness to His promise of sending His Son to be our Savior.

READING: There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse, and a branch from His roots shall bear fruit. And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the LORD. *Isaiah 11:1-2*

READING: Knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot. *1 Peter 1:18-19*

And he dreamed, and behold, there was a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven. And behold, the angels of God were ascending and descending on it! And behold, the LORD stood above it and said, “I am the LORD, the God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac. The land on which you lie I will give to you and to your offspring. Your offspring shall be like the dust of the earth, and you shall spread abroad to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south, and in you and your offspring shall all the families of the earth be blessed. *Genesis 28:10–14*

And I have been with you wherever you went and have cut off all your enemies from before you. And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth... And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.’” *2 Samuel:8-9, 16*

And so I intend to build a house for the name of the LORD my God, as the LORD said to David my father, ‘Your son, whom I will set on your throne in your place, shall build the house for My name.’” *1 Kings 5:2–5*

READING: In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.” For this is he who was spoken of by the prophet Isaiah when he said, “The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord; make His paths straight.’” Now John wore a garment of camel’s hair and a leather belt around his waist, and his food was locusts and wild

honey. Then Jerusalem and all Judea and all the region about the Jordan were going out to him, and they were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. *Matthew 3:1–6*

Jesus is Conceived Symbol: Mary

READING: In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin’s name was Mary. And he came to her and said, “Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!” But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His father David, and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.” *Luke 1:26–33*

Jesus is Born Symbol: Manger

READING: Luke, chapter 2. In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town.

And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child.

And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no place for them in the inn.
