## Children's Ministry Report (Birth-Grade 6) September 2022 (Update 9/12/22)

## Sunday School -

Rally Day – We filled the fellowship hall with families on Rally Day, September 11<sup>th</sup>! We welcomed four new families to our Sunday school. Our theme for the school year is Deuteronomy 11:18, which reminds us to keep God's Word in our daily lives. We had a skit, devotion, and family craft based on our theme verse. About 9:15 teachers and students moved to classrooms to get to know one another. Parents learned more about Sunday school and upcoming family events. Thank you to Sue, Carol, and Paul for their help with snacks!

Sunday School Staff – We have an amazing group of teachers for Sunday school! We will meet on Wednesday, September 7th, to review safety, curriculum, and general procedures. Ages 2&3 – Emily Rottier, Kayden Halsey; 4-5-K – Karen Behrens, RJ Behrens; Grades 1&2 – Jen Kasmarek, Linda Stenschke; Grades 3&4 – Katrina Kadlec, Amy Kufahl; Grades 5&6 – Jaci Larsen, Holly Highstrom; Grades 7&8 Rick Behrens, Lynn Parker; Puppeteers – Vicki Holewinski, RJ Behrens; Openings/Music – Marlene Rieck; Substitute Teachers - Laura Lorenz, Carol Pluedeman, Jaclyn Halsey

Curriculum – This will be the third year of using the Enduring Faith Curriculum from Concordia Publishing House for kindergarten-grade 8. We are back to Year 1 – A Bible Overview. Each Sunday all grade levels (except ages 2 & 3) will study the same Bible account. Family activity sheets for each lesson will allow families to continue growing in God's Word throughout the week. Ages 2 & 3 will continue using Kingdom Quest by Kids Kount Publishing. Parents of 2 & 3 year olds can look for "God Talk" sheets to review lessons at home.

Memory Treasures – Bible verses from our curriculum were chosen for our memory verse for each month. Students in grades 1-8 receive Bible pins for memorizing each verse and parts of the Catechism.

Bible Reading Challenge – After some research, I have created a Bible reading passport for the first unit of our Sunday school curriculum that children can complete with their parents with a few incentives. The goal is to have children and families growing in faith through God's Word. After Unit 1 is completed the end of November, I will reevaluate the passport for Unit 2.

Mission Project – Our fall mission project will be Operation Christmas Child. OCC, a ministry of Samaritan's Purse, sends shoe box gifts to children in need around the world. There is a display in the narthex so families and individuals can shop and fill boxes at home. I will also ask for specific gift donations such as toothbrushes, new small toys, school supplies, etc. for a packing party during the education hour on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup>. Christmas Service – Our children's Christmas service will be Sunday, December 18th, at 10 am. The tentative plan is a service called "From the Cradle to the Cross" by Adele Bluhm, a former teacher of Pastor Kufahl's. Watch for a rehearsal schedule to be announced.

Paint Classrooms – Our 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms are the next two rooms to be painted in the lower level. Paint colors and theme suggestions are welcome!

### Family Ministry / Cradle Roll -

Doughnuts & Blessings – Pastor was at church on the first day of school, Thursday, September 1<sup>st</sup>, starting at 7 am, giving out doughnuts and blessings. Thank you, Pastor!

Backpack Blessing – Thank you to all the children that participated in our backpack blessing on Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup>. Children received a backpack tag and parents received Bible verse cards to include in lunch boxes and bags to remind children that Jesus is always with them.

Bibles – Our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders received their first Bibles and 2 & 3 year olds received their picture Bibles on Rally Day. Our Bible blessing will take place on Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup>, at both services. A Bible Blast-Off (or overview) will tentatively take place for 3<sup>rd</sup> graders and their parents on Sunday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, during the education hour.

Family Curriculum – Pastor is reviewing a RightNow Media resource called "Talking with Your Kids about Jesus" by Natasha Crain. This six-session course gives parents encouragement and practical tips for having intentional and meaningful faith conversations in the home. The sessions include helpful tips for parents with children of all ages.

<u>VBS 2023</u> – I ordered "Keepers of the Kingdom" VBS curriculum and supplies from Answers in Genesis for the summer of 2023. I took advantage of discounts and free shipping. We will still need to purchase t-shirts and digital music to share. This curriculum based on the Armor of God from Ephesians 6 looks like an outstanding theme and important topic for us! We still need to order t-shirts and the digital music for families.

## **Humble Stewards**

As stewards, we are the recipients and caretakers of God's goodness, love, mercy, and grace. Stewards are managers of God's creation. We acknowledge God as the owner; therefore, we are to act not as owners but as managers because our lives and resources are simply on loan from Him.

The book of Daniel gives an account of a man who failed to recognize God as Creator and provider and exalted himself. King Nebuchadnezzar, walking on the roof of "his" royal palace, surveying "his" kingdom, was overcome by pride as he announced, "Is not this the great Babylon I have built as the royal residence, by my mighty power and for the glory of my majesty" (Daniel 4:30)? He thought he was asking a rhetorical question, but God condemned him to live like an animal as a consequence of his pride.

Pride is destructive. It destroys gratitude to God for all His kindness to us. It destroys our desire and ability to serve others. It destroys contentment for it feeds our competitive nature so that we are not satisfied with just being wealthy or intelligent, but we want to be wealthier and more intelligent than anyone else.

Pride has no place in the life of a servant. First Peter 5:6 reads, "Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand that He may lift you up in due time." It is God alone Who can exalt us (Psalm 75:7). If Christ Himself, God's only begotten Son, humbled Himself, should we not follow His example and humble ourselves? Because Christ humbled Himself, God exalted Him (Philippians 2:9)

David, the shepherd-king, put our situation in proper perspective: "When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have set in place, what is man that You are mindful of him, the son of man that You care for him" (Psalm 8:3-4)? The inference is that we are insignificant, yet David goes on to remind us of what we can be proud: "You made [us] ruler over the works of Your hands; You put everything under [our] feet."

Humility allows us to accept our smallness and God's goodness. In the words of Martin Luther, humility is the decision to "let God be God". We are stewards through humility. We are to honor Him with what we have, what we are, and what He will make of us.
