
The key component in "vitality" is the word "vital." Vital means essential or necessary, but it also has the idea of life. We believe that wherever the Word of God is proclaimed in its purity and the Sacraments are rightly administered according to our Lord's promise and command, there he is giving life to his people – new life, spiritual life, eternal life! The Re:Vitality program is designed to build upon the congregation's spiritual vitality and guide it towards positive action for sustainable, adaptable, focused and healthy ministry for years to come.

We are asking everyone 18 and older to give honest feedback about our congregation through the Re:Vitality survey. A link will be emailed out to everyone on November 12, 2023 with a Logon Code for you to participate. If you are not able to access the survey online, printed copies will be made available for you to complete. Your responses will be entered for you anonymously.

It is important that we hear from as many people as possible. Whether you've been a lifelong believer, or a new Christian; whether you are a member, frequent attendee or occasional visitor; we want to hear from everyone. Each member of a family who is 18 or older should fill out their own survey.



even for us. For to the one who has, more will be given, and he will have an abundance.




Prayer Shawls
