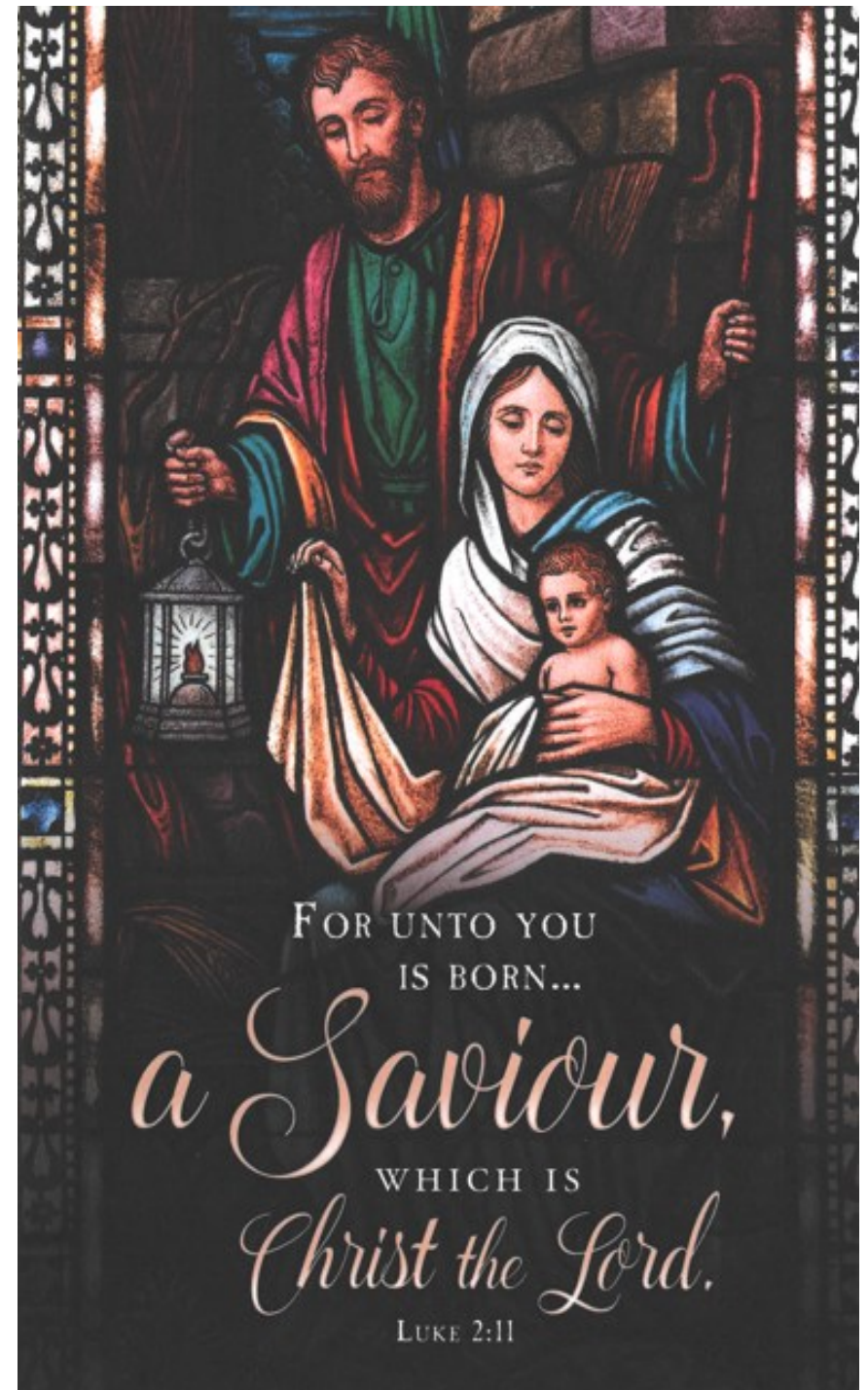

INVOCATION

P: God has shown His everlasting love and mercy by sending us His Son Jesus Christ. The Savior has taken away our sin and brought us perfect forgiveness. As a called and ordained servant of the Word, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
