

## Requirements and Considerations of Indoor Worship at Spirit of Christ Church

The following Plan has been developed with guidance from the CDC and “Industry Guidance for Safely Reopening: Faith-Based Communities, Places of Worship, Weddings, and Funerals” from the state of Minnesota.

Your adherence to the following points while inside the Spirit of Christ Building for Worship is **Required:**

(\*These requirements have the potential to change on short notice, so your flexibility is much appreciated.)

1. **If you are feeling ill, have symptoms of Covid-19, or have an elevated temperature, please do not enter the building**
2. **Staff – If you are sick, please stay home**
  - a. **Download Screening checklist if....**
    - i. **If you have COVID-19**
    - ii. **Any other employee has tested positive for COVID-19**
    - iii. **After 14 days, you may return to work**
    - iv. **Communicate with other employees regarding your timing for return**
3. **Face Coverings are required of all members, visitors and children of the age of 2 years while in the sanctuary Including:**
  - a. **During the signing of the hymns**
  - b. **Approaching the Alter for Communion**
4. **Social distancing of at least 6 feet is required while seated in the Sanctuary**
5. **Utilization of hand sanitizer upon entry and exit of the Sanctuary**
6. **While receiving communion, follow the instruction of the Ushers as to when to approach the alter**
7. **Limiting the number of people in restrooms, to allow for social distancing**
8. **Offering will be collected at the door, to avoid unnecessary contact**
