Amen" (Jude 24-25).

Prayer - God and Savior, I know that You are with us as promised. Give me the eyes of faith to see Your glory hidden and revealed in your gifts of water, bread and wine of the sacraments. When I feel crushed and helpless, speak to me, as You spoke to Moses, in Your Holy Word. Strengthen me and uphold me until that day when I see Your glory face to face. Amen.
