Psalm 121:1,2 - I lift up my eyes to the hills—

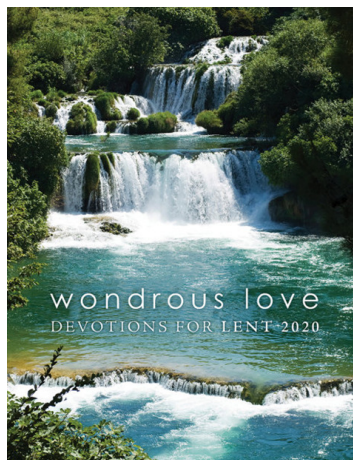
