Transfiguration of Our Lord

WELCOME God reveals His majesty to Moses in flame, shrouded in a mysterious cloud, ultimately preparing Moses to receive the Law of God. Peter, James, and John also bear witness to Jesus' majesty on the mount of Transfiguration. But of paramount importance is not just the glorious appearance of Jesus but the revelation of something more sure His prophetic Word. This is the very Word that demands our listening, inspires our believing and confirms our confessions.
