Being Faithful in Small Things

In Luke 16:10 Jesus said, *“One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much, and one who is dishonest in a very little is also dishonest in much”* We often fail to see the witness of Christian faith and conduct that we can communicate in little things: how we deal with our neighbors around the block, how we value our conversations with our children or our parents, how well we do our homework, perhaps even our ethics on the golf course, or how we play a game of cards. Our consistency of conduct, and our honoring of principles will be seen in the “little things,” for these constitute the practice field for the big things in life, those things that God entrusts to us. Jesus goes on to say, *“If then you have not been faithful in the unrighteous wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches?”* (verse 11). The unrighteous wealth is a small thing in contrast to the value of the Gospel, so if we aren’t faithful with things of this world, we can’t be trusted with true riches.
