### Helping Others

Has any Bible reader not heard of Dorcas (Tabitha)? The Holy Spirit inspired Luke to write of this disciple in the following way: "*[She] was always doing good and helping the poor*" (Acts 9:36). Let us have the same humility of heart as we go about serving others, offering that ". . . *cup of water in [Christ's] name*" (Mark 9:41).
