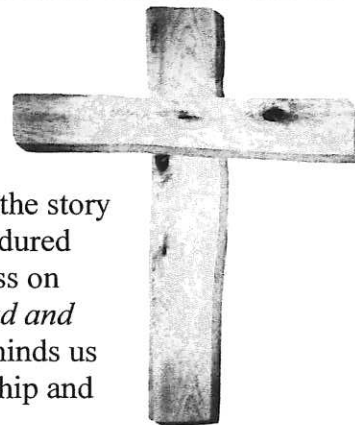


## Mid-Week Stewardship Thought
