You Shall Have No Other Gods

The first commandment, "You shall have no others gods" makes it clear that the God Who created us expects us to give Him first place in our hearts and lives. God may have to get our attention as He did the Rich Fool (Luke 12:13-21). Relying on God instead of ourselves, we can prevent the things of this world from becoming overly important.
