Titus 3:5–8

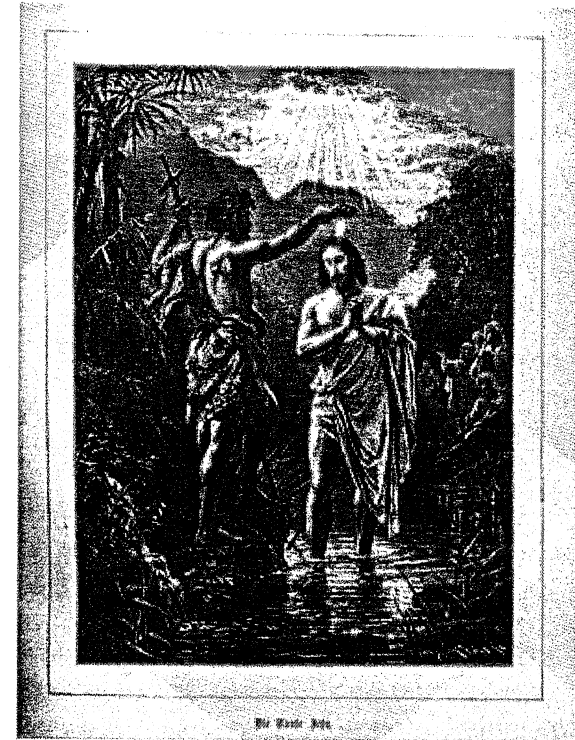
