The kindergarten class offers a structured academic setting with a student-teacher ratio of 17:1. All academic subjects are taught along with all the familiar Bible stories. Field trips are planned to enhance the curricular areas of study. Kindergarten is available as a half day or full day experience.

Kindergarten Academics	
Religion	Large group presentation of Jesus Time, Old and New Testament Bible stories are taught. Students worship weekly in chapel with the entire school.
Language Arts	A language-rich environment is provided to help students connect words with the meanings.
Math	Hands-on experiences, free exploration, and other learning activities introduce math concepts, such as sorting and classifying, money recognition, shapes, fractions, and telling time.
Science	Real experiences promote the understanding of the scientific process.
Social Studies	Themes are used to introduce concepts of community and our country.
Music	The basic unit of music follows the High Scope Foundation philosophy.
Computers	Introduction of basic computer terms and procedures. Software reinforces the concepts taught in class.
