### Second Grade Academics

<b>Religion</b>	Students learn to apply God's principles to their daily life through prayer, singing, Bible study, leading chapel, and mission projects, memory work
<b>Language Arts</b>	Sentence structure, parts of speech, recognize main ideas, sequence, dictionary skills, writing styles, word patterns, point of view, adding prefixes and suffixes, rhyme, Accelerated Reader, spelling, handwriting
<b>Math</b>	Addition, subtraction, place value, money, reading graphs, geometry, measurement, problem solving, weight, capacity, temperature, multiplication, division
<b>Science</b>	Physical and Natural science, cause and effect, discovery, observation, classifying, communicating, sequencing, measuring, recording and interpreting data
<b>Social Studies</b>	Community laws, geography, globe, maps, history, traditions of our land, selected foreign countries
<b>Music</b>	Quarter, half, and whole notes, creating and performing rhythm patterns
<b>Computer</b>	Technology utilized within the instruction and software reinforces the concepts taught in class.
