Fifth Grade Academics	
Religion	Encouragement is given to put in action the following key concepts: Law, Gospel, confession, repentance, forgiveness, prayer, grace
Language Arts	Recognition and construction of complete sentences, proper usage of parts of speech, using simple rules of grammar
Math	Review place value, whole numbers, operations, decimals, fractions, problem solving, statistics, graphing, probability, measurement, geometry, ratios, percents
Science	Explore the earth and its resources, water cycle, weather and patterns, matter, acids, bases, sound, light energy, laws of motion
Social Studies	History and geography of the United States, maps, timelines, charts, graphs
Music	Exploration of the fundamentals of music and its application in the human experience
Art	Exploration of the basic elements of art: line, shape, movement, color, value, texture, variety, space, proportion, repetition, pattern, balance
Computers	File management, keyboarding, Microsoft Office programs
