Seventh Grade Academics	
<b>Religion</b>	Study God's Word from a Lutheran perspective using <i>Luther's Small Catechism</i>
<b>Language Arts</b>	Listen, read, discuss, and write about different genres, exploration of novels, Accelerated Reader program
<b>Math</b>	Emphasis on arithmetic, practical problem solving, logical thinking
<b>Science</b>	Classification system, cell development and specialization, the five kingdoms, development, structure, and interactions of the human body systems
<b>Social Studies</b>	Geography, history, culture, government, and economics of the Western Hemisphere
<b>Music</b>	Exploration of the fundamentals of music and its application in the human experience
<b>Art</b>	Exploration of the basic elements of art: line, shape, movement, color, value, texture, variety, space, proportion, repetition, pattern, balance
<b>Computers</b>	File management, keyboarding, Microsoft Office programs, internet access and conducting searches
