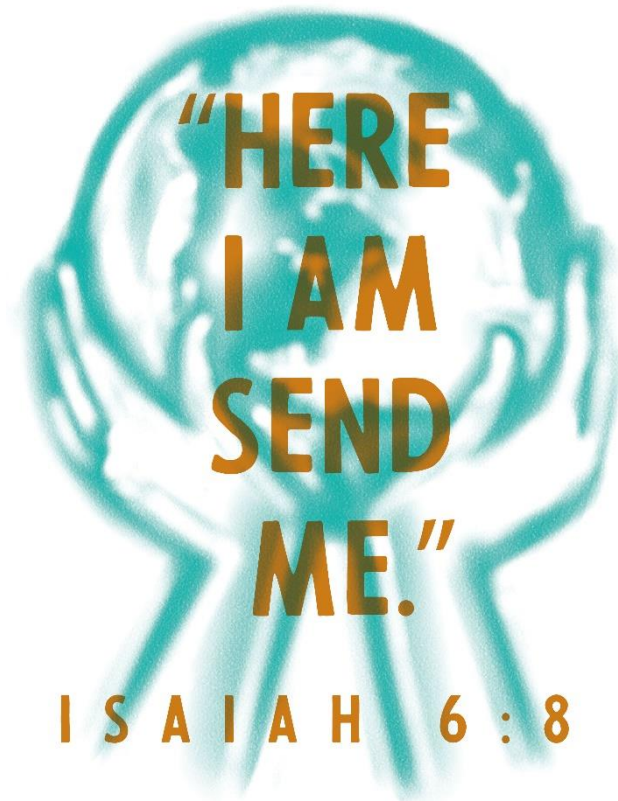

For over a year the church council has been looking ahead into and identifying what our congregation's future needs will be with the hope that we can put together a 5 and 10 year plan to address both maintenance and expansion needs. One of the areas that we have discussed is the possibility of needing additional land for parking space and building expansion. Much of the land that we currently own is needed for "green space," or drainage land for the water runoff from the hard surfaces like our building roofs and parking lot. The one thing that they aren't making more of in the village is land. Most of the residential land in the village is already developed and the area around our church is most likely the next area that homes will be built upon as it is developed. Members of the council approached Jerome Jadin who owns the land to the west of us to see what land would be available according to the development plan that he put together for houses around the church, and at what price. He gave us an option of buying around 2 acres, or of buying around 6 acres. This information was presented at the Feb. 3 voter's meeting and the members present voted to approve spending up to \$100,000 dollars on purchasing the around 6 acres of land to the west of our current property. This land will also connect to a new road that will be part of the future residential development around us. The church council continues to put together a plan to address the future needs of the congregation and will be communicating elements of that plan over the next few years.
