Ruby's Pop-Up Pantry – St. John's Site in Luxemburg has received notice of a price increase from Ruby's Pantry Corporate Office. As of November, the price per share will increase from \$20 to \$22. This is the first price increase Ruby's has passed along in over 8 years.

Each share will continue to contain some meat/protein, pizza, potatoes, dairy, bread and/or baked goods, vegetables and a variety of other food products as well as paper goods and will have a retail value between \$100-150.

Ruby's Pantry is not government funded and is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. Each donation is used to cover operational costs like trucking, gas, and warehouse staff. All of the food is donated by corporate food donors making it possible to reach more families each month at locations across Minnesota and Wisconsin. Thank you for understanding.
