C.F.W. Scholz, representing four generations, came to visit the "Jesus Sends You" Missionary Chapel (the Old Church), our current sanctuary, and cemetery. Ruth Schnake, of Effingham, Scholz's great-granddaughter, aged 91, presented to St. John's an autograph book from the 1840's. Scholz had his relatives, friends, and supporters in Germany write messages for him as he journeyed through German lands as a young dye maker, while he was a student for the ministry, and before he left Germany. A few pieces of color artwork are included and also a wreath that his sister braided for him out of her own hair. (As far as we know, he never saw his siblings again after he left Germany in 1846, at the age of 23.) There is also an autographed message from Pastor J.K. Wilhelm Loehe, one of the fathers of the Lutheran church in America, who trained him. (See pages 8-16 of the history book.) Pastor Meseke translated all the messages in the 1990's. Until a few weeks ago, we did not know that this document existed. It fits very well with the "Jesus Sends You" theme. We will try to make copies and reproductions available; for now it is locked in the fire-proof file cabinet.
