WE WELCOME IN THE NAME OF JESUS Pastor Jaya P. Bijjiga, of St. Louis. (After conduction the service at Covington, Pastor Mueller will be at Olive Branch for their 10:00 a.m. worship and quarterly Voters' Meeting.) Pastor Bijjiga is with the Asian Indian Mission of North America. Born in India, Pastor Bijjiga was ordained as a Pastor in India in 1976, in connection with the British Wesleyan Church / Church of South India. While serving in India he was involved in education ministry and in the production of Sunday School materials. In the 1970's many of his wife's family members immigrated to the United States, where "they are all medical doctors." Finally, in 1990, Pastor Bijjiga and his wife Pravi (which means "beautiful") also came to the United States. He resisted the urging of his relatives to become a doctor or an engineer and instead entered the colloquy program at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, in order to become an LCMS Pastor. In 1992 he was called by the Northern Illinois District. Working out of St. John, Forest Park, he was charged with starting new churches and raising up leaders. Along the way he has also worked for the Missouri District and served as Counselor for Asian Indian Missions for the national LCMS. Over the years the Lord used him to start some 20 congregations all around the U.S.; he has also been instrumental in raising up six Asian Indian pastors. He still has connections with St. John, Forest Park, and also with Zion, Maryland Heights, MO, and Mt. Calvary, St. Louis. He is currently involved in a "faith ministry" working without the security of a regular position or salary, ministering to Asian Indians, often conducting worship in the homes of Christians who have invited their non-Christian friends, seeking to bring them all into active membership in established congregations. His wife Pravi is a retired nurse. They have been blessed with two children: a son Stephen in Kansas City, and daughter Snigdhe, who is married with four children in Springfield, MO. Pastor Bijjiga continues to be a big help filling in at Olive Branch. He has earned a Doctor of Ministry degree and speaks several languages besides his native Teluguo and Hindi, the national language of India. He is also a vocalist and plays 22 different instruments. Like many old German pastors, he enjoys chanting the liturgy in worship. He appreciates the faithful doctrinal position of the LCMS and says, "If we have the pure Gospel, why should we keep it for ourselves?"
