St. John Lutheran Church, New Minden Quarterly Voter's Meeting-April 27, 2023

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dean Sprehe with 24 members present. Pastor Mueller began the meeting with opening devotion from Mathew Chapter 9 and prayer. Minutes from the previous meetings were approved as read. (January 26, 2023, and April 2, 2023)

Principal's Report: Mrs. Kurtz shared the following.

- Students walked to the State theatre to watch "SING" the movie as the result of a generous sponsor.
- Several class trips are scheduled.
- Servant Day will be May 5th @ St. John's
- Graduation is scheduled for May 15th at 6:30 p.m.
- The last day of school attendance will be May 17th.
- Friday Fun Day donations will be given to Kellsie's Hope. This was sponsored by the Junior Honor Society.
- A walk-in freezer will be installed soon; paid with COVID funds.
- T-SJ on-line auction to pay for new playground equipment will be May12th, Lehde auction is in charge of the event. Many thanks to the Auction committee for putting it all together.
- The old playground equipment has been sold for \$7,000.

Motion made, seconded, and approved to accept the principal's report.

Pastor Mueller noted this will be Mrs. Kurtz last meeting since she will be moving to Georgia in June.

The members applauded her efforts and 7 years of service to T-SJ.

<u>School Treasurer's Report:</u> In the absence of school treasurer Martha Polczynski, Clint Dunn presented the T-SJ school treasurer's report showing a negative balance of \$-3,167.46. It is expected to correct itself with tuition payments. Motion made, seconded, and approved to accept the School Treasurer's report.

<u>School Board:</u> Clinton Dunn reported that the BOCE Call committee would be generating a new list to Call a principal. In addition, there is a full-time and a part time position open at T-SJ.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Treasurer Andi Hoffman reported an approximate \$3600 General account budget deficit and \$1800 synod budget deficit. The first quarter checking account balance is \$28,457.01.

<u>Finance Board:</u> For the Finance Board, Marla Hempen recommended going to generic stamped envelopes which could be used for any collection. Members would need to record their member number and choose which collection they were supporting. This would save the congregation several hundred dollars. Motion made, seconded, and approved to go with the Finance Board recommendation of using a generic envelope.

Pastor's Report: The radio bible study continues to be supported thru July. The recent confirmands as a group were very good to work with. As Olive Branch vacancy pastor, he has had to schedule preachers for Olive Branch. There are several vacancies in the area: Venedy/Olive Branch, Carlyle, luka, and Mt Vernon. Pastor Bijjiga will preach Sunday for Mission Sunday while Pastor Mueller is at Olive Branch. The 'Old Chapel' restoration is nearly complete as the result of several thousand volunteer hours; we pray it will be a Blessing for years to come. Approximately 60 people attended the Circuit Good Friday worship and shared positive comments. St. Luke's Covington has increased their annual support to \$10,000. He offered thanks to any who contributed to the "Read to Me Bible" campaign. We are encouraged to pray for the Call process for a new principal. On Saturday, May

27th, Trinity, Nashville will be having a Farewell and God's Speed service for Mrs. Kurtz. He also reported having the opportunity to baptize a 64-year-old in the hospital that was the spouse of an Olive Branch member.

First quarter statistics: Baptized members 354, Communicant members 286, Sunday service 86, Saturday service 17, Weekend 90 (pre-Covid attendance was 99 per weekend), Sunday School 8, Sunday adult Bible Class 15, 116 communed at least once, one baptism (Maylee Ibendahl), one funeral (Pearl Twenhafel). Motion made, seconded, and approved Pastor Mueller's report.

Elder's Report: Per the recommendation of the Elders:

Motion made, seconded, and approved the transfer of Kevin Kellerman to Christ the King in Lodi, Ohio. Motion made, seconded, and approved the transfer of Billy Temme from Trinity, Nashville. Motion made, seconded, and approved four Mission Projects at \$100 each (Lutheran Hour Ministries Float; Evergreen Lutheran School in Detroit, Michigan; David & Kathleen Garrett, serving with "Jews for Jesus"; and Epiphany Lutheran church, Jackson, Mississippi) with funding to come from the Mission Projects fund. Motion made, seconded, and approved five Mission Projects at \$1,000 for one year and will be addressed annually (Lutheran Braille Workers Work center #315, New Minden; Unity Lutheran Christian Elementary School, East St. Louis; Dr. Hans Trinklein Missionary support; Jon & Carol Shaneyfelt, serving with Lutheran Bible Translators; and Pastor Jason & Anna Marie Stephenson, LCMS Theological Educator in Tanzania) with funding to come from the Mission Projects fund and Sunday offerings designated for those purposes...

The group from several local churches meeting as David's Harp will now be called "Christ Our Song Lutheran School of Music". The goal is to use music to proclaim the gospel by raising up organists & other church musicians for the future. Possible instructors include Pastor Eichhorn (organ), Mrs. Diane Backs (grandparents & kids), and Mike Trinklein (piano). Music materials may be purchased thru funding from Thrivent (these will also be shared with local organist Kathy Unverfehrt). So that an account can be set up, it is necessary for this group to be an auxiliary group of the church. The Treasurer must be a communicant member, Cheryl Twenhafel has agreed to this role. Motion made, seconded, and approved startup funds in the amount of \$2,000 from the Special Projects fund for Christ Our Song Lutheran School of Music as an auxiliary group of the church with Cheryl Twenhafel as appointed Treasurer.

Trustees: Nothing to report.

<u>Cemetery Committee:</u> Nothing to report.

Scholarship Treasurer's Report: Nothing to report.

<u>Old Business:</u> Motion made, seconded, and approved the proposed By-Law change regarding an Endowment Fund for the second time with a show of hands vote.

New Business: It was suggested that we might consider dropping participation in the Fall Festival and add a Fall Dinner. If we continued with participation in the Fall festival, maybe modify the menu to fewer items to prepare as it is difficult to find enough help to man the stand.

The Illinois State Historical Society (ISHS) is in the process of giving recognition to churches that have served congregations for 150 years or more and has invited St. John's to apply. Motion made, seconded, and approved to complete the application for Sesquicentennial recognition. There is a one-time fee of \$50.

Motion made, seconded and approved to adjourn. The meeting closed with "The Lord's Prayer".
