### **Psalms 119:105 (ESV)**

### **Genesis 12:2–3 (ESV)**

And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

### **Exodus 3:14 (ESV)**

### **Isaiah 9:6 (ESV)**

### **Galatians 4:4–5 (ESV)**
