Topic to be covered:

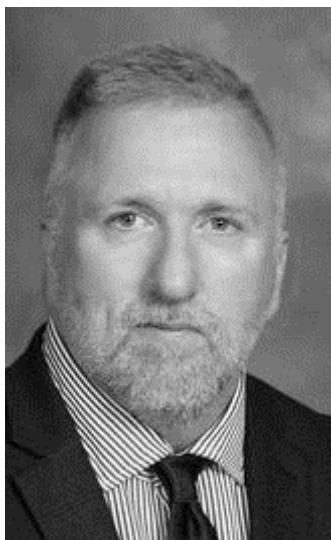
- Exegetical considerations of exorcism: Jesus' dealings with the demonic

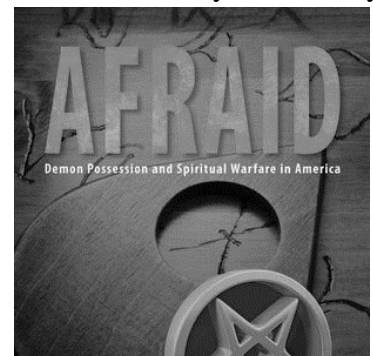

**Rev. Dr. Robert Bennett** is dedicated to studying the topic of spirituality. His scope of research includes various forms of animism found in the contents of North America, South America, Africa, Asia, and Europe. His book titled, "I Am Not Afraid: Demon Possession and Spiritual Warfare" is one of the few published and peer reviewed resources available to the scholarly community on the topic of exorcism. His second book, "Afraid: Demon Possession and Spiritual Warfare in American," turns his attention to the American fascination with spiritualism and demonstrates how it leads to a spirit of captivity and fear. Bennett is also a guest lecturer at numerous International Seminaries, Guest professor of Missions at Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, IN and the Executive Director of Luther Academy, located in Fort Wayne Indiana.
